Flood victims, new housing, need for church building.

If you get our bi-monthly email updates you are aware that we had very bad flooding in Siguatepeque. One of our girls was at a school project and the water was up to her neck. News announced that 500 homes were flooded and 2,000 people were being fed. Our son's church helped feed some of the people. Nathan and Manuel worked with the Red Cross in various areas of need, clothing and such. The president of Honduras flew into Siguatepeque by helicopter to survey the damage and promised to build 50 new homes just a few blocks from our new mission work. Another group has already started building new homes. Please pray that we can get a building up and the mission established to attend this addition to our neighborhood.
