In our recent newsletter, we told you about our team leader Mark, while attending the Siberian Spring Conference, experienced dental pain due to a needle that had been broken off during a recent root canal. The British dentist informed him that the infection had affected five teeth. Pray for his quick recovery from the infection so he will be able to return to China as soon as possible.

While in London, for the next few weeks, Mark will be putting the finishing touches to a new ministry in China titled "Transcultural People." The purpose of this venture is to open the hearts and minds of ordinary people who have not been exposed to the one true God. The ministry is designed to break down ignorance and prejudice between people of different cultures and ethnic origins. It is designed to feature small people groups in Mongolia, Northern China, Russian Siberia and various people groups within the Central Asian grasslands. Included in the material is recordings and audio short stories to attract the interest of these basic unreached groups

Pray for this important step in finalizing this ministry using material left over from the Cambridge Radio Course that has now been converted to a digital format.

You will be glad to know that the Fellowship of European Broadcasters has had success in broadcasting in 20 countries to over 283 million people. There has been success in broadcasting in Kenya and Zimbabwe. We ask you to be in prayer for the "Spotlight" radio programs which are series of fifteen minute broadcasts similar to our original "Moments of Melody" which we produced in 1968.
