Please pray for our annual **men's conference September 6**th and 7th. Once again my Dad, Missionary Harold Priday will be the speaker. Our theme will be <u>Visionary Leaders</u>. We will have it overnight this time at the same place where the teens have camp. This will give them the opportunity to get away from the noise of the rat race and to be more focused on the conference. We are expecting men from at least seven churches. One of the greatest needs here is for **men to be leaders** in their homes and churches.

In the **mission work in Barrio Abajo** we continue studying the book of Revelation on Sunday nights. The youth are studying the Sermon on the Mount on Saturdays, Practical Christian Service, and in Sunday School we are finishing a study on Lifestyle Stewardship. There is much sickness this time of the year, including near epidemic proportions of the dengue fever. It comes from the bite of a certain type of mosquitoes. So please **pray for our health and the health of the people here**.
