Yes, I know what you are thinking. That is a looong way away from Mexico. They don't even speak the same language! How can God want Melissa Houston to go to Croatia? Well...I can't say that I fully understand all of the reasons, but I do know that Croatia is where God now wants me. I was able to take a trip there, and I see so much potential for children's ministries, there. I will be working with Johnny and Tori Leslie, and Scott and Traci Holcomb. The Leslie's have been missionaries in Croatia for 11 years, and the Holcomb's have been missionaries there for 2 years. They are the only Independent Baptists that we know of, in the whole country. I will be going to start Neighborhood Bible Clubs. I will also help in the local churches in areas such as Music, Children, Women, Vacation Bible Schools, and anywhere else I can be used. I am very much looking forward to my new opportunity of service! God has given me a "peace that passeth all understanding." Although I am sad about leaving Mexico, I am very excited about going to Croatia. God has been so good to me. Please pray that I will be able to raise the additional monthly support that I will need quickly so that I can serve on the field of Croatia.
