Daniel Reyna, graduated in 2016 and is graduate #86. He comes to us from the Iglesia Bautista Emaús, in Apodaca. He was saved and baptized under the pastor's ministry (Eliud Chapa), called to preach, and is involved as a Sunday school teacher, in the music ministry, and in the visitation program of the church.

Pray that he will follow God's leadership in His life as to where He would have him serve.

Jesús Barba, graduated in 2016 and is **graduate #87**. He was saved in another ministry and I had the privilege of baptizing him. I called him my "tree man" for he donated & planted several trees around the church building. He was active in Bible School since he started in 2012, helping as a teacher in the Sunday school and being one of the head ushers. The Lord has called him to Dominican Republic to serve as a missionary! (Pray as he follows through with an intern program to help him with his calling.)
