With the great deforestation due to the pine beetle last year, the flooding is worse. So is the society. As people's consciences are destroyed and hardened by sin, sin grows rampant. The only Hope for Honduras truly is Christ.

August 27th we were invited to the anniversary service of the first work my parents started in 1977. I was privileged to preach. We had a wonderful time and they fixed lunch for everyone. Last week the pastor's nephew was found dead on the side of the road, murdered. My parents, Alba and I went to the funeral and I was asked to preach at the "funeral home" and my Dad at the cemetery. My Dad estimated that there were about 500 people inside and in the yard within hearing. I preached a message of hope and salvation. We praise the Lord that a young lady accepted Christ as her Savior after the message. Please pray for Gregoria Fonseca and all that family.

Please be in prayer for these elections that there will be no fraud nor violent reactions. Thank you again for your prayers and financial support.
