SUMMER SUMMARY - IBM CAMP

Indian Baptist Missions has sponsored a camp for Native people and workers for many years



in Canadian, Oklahoma, under the direction of Bro. Josh Harjo. We were able to take a group of our folks this year. While there, Bro. Ryan Nez, our youth pastor, was asked to preach. During the invitation after he preached to the camp teens, there were 14 saved!! Pray for Ryan and his wife, Amber. The summer Vacation Bible Schools are a great opportunity for evangelism. The Lord blessed in a mighty way and we praise His name for all He did. We assisted with the VBS in Lukachukai at Mountain View

Baptist Church, which we started years ago. We saw a record attendance on the last day of 190 attendees (not including workers). The average attendance was 163 and there were 40 saved. The VBS at Ganado was the best attended ever. The average was 112 with a high day of 131. There were 15 precious souls saved. The VBS at Nazlini was held in conjunction

with a revival meeting. The average attendance was 82 and there were 26 saved.



Our son Joel and his wife, Fabiola, planted Solid Rock Baptist Church this summer! We had a special service at




Ganado to send them out. The first official service was July 29th. On that first day, there were 87 present. There were many visitors from out of town and a good number from the local community. Over the past few weeks, the attendance has settled into the 20's to the 40's. It has been a great start, but not without challenges, of course. Please pray that they will get electricity to the church site soon. Working with the Tribe and the Tribal utility company can be adventurous. Solid Rock had their first baptism service just this past Sunday with two baptized! Pray for God's blessings as Joel and Fabi seek to establish this lighthouse in a dark place.


SUMMER SUMMARY - THE BIRTH OF GANADO BAPTIST BIBLE COLLEGE
