#### A NEW BUILDING RISES IN GANADO!!



In our last newsletter, we showed you some photos of the new building being delivered by truck. Well, that new building is now off of the ground and up on a slab! It was an amazing transformation! We hired a local man to have his work crew prepare for and pour the slab. The Lord blessed in that he agreed to do the job even though we did not have enough money to cover the entire project. We will be giving him \$1,000 a month until the entire project is paid off. This man (unsaved) said he trusted our church and wanted to help us. He did not make a profit on the project.

About two weeks after the slab was poured, a group of men from Greater Waco Baptist Church arrived to erect the steel building. Bro. Tom Wright led the group. He makes several trips a year to put up buildings as a ministry. What happened over the next 48 hours was astounding! This group of eight men was up before dawn and



moved the building into place near the slab. Folks went to work from Ganado on Friday and saw a slab. When they returned that evening, there was a building! On our website, we have chronicled the building process from the arrival of the building by truck to the finished product. Stop by and see the transformation! There remains much work to be done. The

windows have been ordered and the inside needs to be framed, wired, etc. We have committed not to borrow money, so we will work with what we have and what comes in. If the Lord leads you to do so, we would truly appreciate any financial help you could give. Our home church recently sent \$5,000 to help. We know the Lord will provide and it is good

for our folks to learn to trust Him daily and watch Him work!! We will continue to provide updates as to the building progress.

#### A NEW OPPORTUNITY RISES IN CHAMBERS ARIZONA!!

We have a goal of seeing ten churches born in Navajoland over the next ten years. Solid Rock Baptist Church in Nazlini was the first step. Now God has opened an amazing door in the community of Chambers. This small, unincorporated place is a border town just off of Reservation land. It is near Navajo communities that total around 4,000 souls. There is an unbelievable opportunity to purchase a three acres site with a 40' x 60' metal building and a mobile home for \$80,000!
