Kelaiah is one of our van kids. She comes on the route that covers the nearby community of Kinlichee. She was one of several of our van ministry kids that had something they wanted Pastor to pray with them about. Little did we know that her grandmother had already passed on. The van driver told me about it after returning from running the route. I went to see Kelaiah and her dad, Ryan. There were a large number of people gathered in the house and they represented a cross section of different belief systems. In Navajo tradition, it is a taboo to speak of death, but the taboo is lifted when a relative passes away. I was able to give the plan of salvation to about 20 people in the room that day. Please pray that there will be fruit from this presentation.

THE WORK GOES ON WHEN THE MISSIONARY IS GONE

We were gone for two weeks in both September and October. The Lord was so good in that the work continued on without a hitch while we were gone. There were people saved and visitors while we were gone. Two of our young men, Ryan and Jonathan, preached twice while we were gone. Bro. Hollifield also preached and did a great job. Praise the Lord for faithful men!!



NAZLINI CHURCH SITE

We are continuing to work on getting an abandoned church site in the community of Nazlini, about 25 miles from Ganado. A building is there that was never occupied. The group that has the rights to it is willing to sell the building to us for \$30,000. Our son, Joel, is planning on starting a work in this community. Please pray for us that we can get all the Federal land site issues taken care of so that we can purchase the building without any legal problems. The site has been surveyed and we are now proceeding with the necessary clearances required by the Tribe and the BIA. If you would like to have a part financially in helping us purchase the building or pay for
