Tyler used to attend our church. He had drifted away, but saw me and asked if we could visit for a while. During our visit, he became concerned about the eternal destiny of his son. He brought Christian (13) to church the following Wednesday night. Christian told me he wanted to “do what his dad had done before.” After the service, I had the privilege of leading Christian to Christ. Now he really is “Christian!”

I received a phone call this past Sunday morning. A young woman on the other end said, “You and your daughter visited me before. When do your services start?” It has been a long time ago that Esther and I had made that visit. This young woman’s boyfriend was murdered by her brother. She came with her aunt and an uncle. During the invitation, she came to the altar and said she was not sure of her salvation. Her childhood friend, Amber Nez (our youth pastor Ryan’s wife), led her to the Lord! We had been praying for her for years!

Jeremy is 29 years old. We have known him for many years. One of our church members, Carolyn, called me to say she had a young man who needed help. Jeremy talked about how he was suicidal and dealing with a lot of personal issues. He had made a profession of faith, but he admitted it was just to please someone. After about an hour, Jeremy called on our Loving Saviour and was saved! Please pray for him. I have started him on a Bible study and he will be accountable to me.
