A Handful of Bread

When needs are great and resources are tight, it is needful to be reminded of God's blessings on those that have gone before us. We have numerous examples from Scripture of those who gave in hard times, and how that was the beginning of God's multiplication. God told Elijah to go to Zarephath where he had commanded a widow woman there to sustain him. This poor widow had only enough for one meal, and yet as she gave what she had to meet the need, God miraculously multiplied her supplies. While she never had supplies in abundance, the barrel of meal wasted not, neither did the cruse of oil fail.

In the New Testament Jesus taught us the same lesson, when twice he multiplied the bread and fish to meet overwhelming needs. In John chapter six, the supplies were five barley loaves and two small fishes, and yet, as Jesus asked God to bless it, he began to divide the little that they had among the 12 disciples. They in turn began to divide their portion among five thousand men. All that were present ate until they were filled. The disciples were used to work a great miracle. They handed out thousands of pounds of food to hungry men, even though they never had more than a handful in their possession at one time. While we may like to see the storehouse full, it is a lot easier to carry a handful of bread than a wagon load.

I believe that God would have us to give out the Bread of Life by the handful. If you have Jesus, you have enough. Gladly give what you have, your supplies will not run out. If we are faithful to do that, one day our Lord will show us the multitudes that were fed. Then he will tell us to pick up the fragments that remain to show us what a great miracle that he performs through us, as we obey the will of the Master and preach the Gospel to every creature.
