In Genesis 1, we read of God's creation of the world and all that is in it. Six times we read where God saw that his Creation was good. In Chapter 2, we hear God tell of something that is not good. "It is not good that the man should be alone." In fact, we read in Revelation 21 of "a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away." In 2 Peter 3:10 the Bible says, "The elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up." But from the first creation, one special and very important thing will be saved. Is this not the whole purpose for the first creation? The bride, the Lamb's wife.

That gives new meaning to Matthew 22:2, "The kingdom of heaven is like unto a certain king, which made a marriage for his son." It also gives new power to verse 9, "Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as ye find, bid to the marriage."
