Twelve-Year Old Criswell Meets John R. Rice

"Good morning." said the charismatic young song leader as he bounded up on the platform. "My name is John R. Rice, and we've come to Texline for a good old-fashioned meeting."

I was twelve years old. I sat in the front row of a large tent that had been erected in an open lot near our house in Texline (Texas). I was fascinated by the song leader. I can't describe the excitement I felt that day when Brother Whaley, pastor of the First Baptist Church of Memphis. Texas, began his two week revival in Texline, assisted by his energetic music man, the young John R. Rice. "Let's stand and sing Onward Christian Soldiers," Rice exclaimed. The pianist played a short, enthusiastic introduction and John R. Rice lifted his arms to lead us in a rousing song.

At the close of the service, I rushed to the platform. "Hey, kid, what's your name?," John R. Rice shouted, shaking my hand and leading me to the group of leaders standing around Brother Whaley. "My name is W. A. Criswell. Jr.," I answered, "and I want to be a preacher too, one day." Rice walked right through the crowd of older men in animated conversation with Brother

"This is W. A. Criswell, Jr.," Rice said. introducing me to our guest preacher. "and one day he's going to be a preacher, too."

"Sit down," Rice said, straddling a rough wooden bench and gesturing for me to join him. "You really want to be a preacher?" "Yes, sir," I answered "more than anything in the world." "Are you sure?," he asked, leaning down toward me to effect a moment of confidentiality between us. "Yes. sir. I am sure."

"Well, let's just turn this over to the Lord.." John R. Rice said at the close of our conversation. Then he surprised me by kneeling beside that rough wooden bench and closing his eyes to pray, "Father," Rice began, "this is W. A. Criswell. Jr., and he feels called to preach. Bless him. Lord. Guide his steps. Go before him a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. Make sure his call is true and use him in building Your kingdom.


