I am excited to introduce Breze Serugamba - IBFI Missionary to Malawi, East Africa. He and his family are sent out of the Cornerstone Baptist Temple, Dayton, Ohio, where Dr. Jerry Siler is pastor. Breze and Chantal have four children: Bliss 10 yrs., Shammah 6 yrs., Lemuel 5 yrs., and Faith 2 yrs. Breze graduated from the Norris Bible Baptist Seminary, and they were appointed missionaries May 2019. The IBFI recommends this missionary family to you. Breze and his family are raising their financial and prayer support as missionaries to the country of Malawi.

I have known Breze since meeting him at a Missions Conference at the Cornerstone Baptist Temple in March, 2013. Breze will be in England for a few months until Visas to the U. S. are in order. As citizens of Great Britain, they plan to begin deputation in the United States next year. I marvel at the path God has used to call Breze to the people of Malawi. Born in Congo, Breze grew up in Rwanda, immigrated to Great Britain; and now God's call is for him to return to Africa.

Dear Colaborers,

Thank you for your prayers and financial support. It is our privilege to be your missionaries in Honduras. After a long dry season, we are now in the rainy season. When it finally started raining, it hasn't hardly stopped, causing flooding in other areas of the country. But everything is a beautiful green and the forest fires have stopped.

Thank you for praying for the annual Youth Camp that we have Easter week, or Holy Week as they say here. The theme was I AM NOT ASHAMED. My Dad, Missionary Harold Priday, a Honduran Pastor, and I taught the book of 1 Timothy. Another missionary, a Honduran Pastor, and I preached the night services. Our son Halbert was in charge of the music and games in the afternoons. The campers are divided into cabins of 4 to 5 with a leader who gives a devotion each morning before breakfast. Our son Steve was one of the cabin leaders. We had an attendance of 63 by the end of the week. Friday night we have a bonfire/Testimony service after the main service. We praise the Lord for those who made decisions to serve the Lord and for one who accepted Christ. Also, we praise the Lord for those who prayed for camp and others who gave financially to help sponsor campers. We thank you greatly.

In the mission work there has been an epidemic of discouragement. That is one of Satan's most favorite tools against us. Please pray that the Lord will strongly touch the hearts and bring revival to the people. We are excited to have several brothers and sisters that want to be baptized and their mother wants to join the church. Please pray for the Flores family.

Thank you again for your prayers and financial support. We have lost some support for different reasons. Please pray for God's provision.

A NATION PLAGUED WITH MORAL INSANITY

We have come through several wars, numerous seasons of depression, and economic woes. But nothing compares to the moral insanity that plagues us in 2019.

No other nation has had the opportunity to be a true Christian nation as has America. Major cities, as well as rural towns, proudly boast of growing churches. Christian schools decorate the horizon. More emphasis has been placed on education to solve our problems, but education is not the answer. Science is not the answer. Industrial development is not the answer. These material, educational, and scientific accomplishments are powerless to salvage America.

I love America, and I would not want to live anywhere else. I love our flag, the symbol of what has made America the greatest nation on earth. I subscribe to the democratic form of government. I believe Capitalism is the best policy for economic growth. Capitalism has made America financially prosperous; Socialism has failed worldwide. I am proud to be an American, and I long to see our nation return to God, the Bible and righteous living!

IS AMERICA A MORALLY INSANE NATION?

In answer to that question, consider the following and make your own assessment:
